Description:

M1 peptide is a synthetic peptide represents residues 58-66 of the influenza A matrix protein. In HLA-A*0201 subjects the CD8+ CTL response is dominated by cells expressing V β 17 and responding to this peptide.

Structure: The sequence of the peptide is GILGFVFTL

Storage: Store frozen at \leq minus 20°C

Activity:

Reconstitute peptide in DMSO. The optimum concentration depends on the specific use of the peptide. To stimulate PBMC, concentrations of 1-10 μ g/mL are appropriate. Specific T cell clones and lines respond well to much lower concentrations.
